I also left you a voicemail.

On the bus yesterday, [REDACTED] was talking with a few other students on the bus and admitted to using the n-word. When I asked him why he said he did it by accident, he was trying to think of a word that starts with N and it just came out.

We are really stressing respect and acceptance and this, even if it was an accident, goes against everything we are working for. I have been very consistent that when a racial slur is used by an MIS student, a substantial consequence is assigned. I have decided that I am going to assign [REDACTED] an in-school suspension for tomorrow which is consistent with other consequences this year.

We will have a substitute teacher work with [REDACTED] throughout the day so he will not miss any instruction but he will not be with his classmates.
