Special Education Activities

- Guidance from The OPI for students with special services during COVID-19 remote learning is "good faith effort". The OPI has acknowledged that meeting learners' minute for minute during this time of crisis is not rationally possible, and requires that districts make an effort in good faith in providing services through virtual meetings, telephone calls and paper packets as needed. The Browning Public Schools SpEd Staff have been making daily calls to their students and guardians, providing therapy and lessons through Google Meet and developing packets that align with individual student Individual Educational Plan goals and objectives.
