Approval of Minutes from October 27, 2016 - Motion by Daniel Bland and seconded by Gayle McRoberts.

Crisis Management Flip Chart Updates

Mr. Bauer's name will be updated on the charts. Death of student or staff member was updated last year. Outside staff attending meeting will update their contact information based off today's sign in sheet.

Annual Safety Drill Schedule

Law enforcement drills and FD drills are planned by end of October, dates to be finalized. Bus evacuations are TBD, no later than mid-October. Severe weather and earthquake drills will be scheduled.

NIMS Training Update

The NIMS training by required staff has been completed. Lori Ade reported that she and Juletta Ellis attended the Christian County Disaster Drill in Taylorville on April 12, 2017. She encouraged others to participate in these drills when offered.

Security System Discussion

No major changes from last year. The Chief of police and dispatch has live access. The elementary and Jr. High buildings have requests for additional cameras that will be considered in the upcoming year. Plan at some point during the year to name the cameras and possibly adjust positioning.

Ms. McRoberts is requesting new gun prohibited signs. Mrs. Zueck is requesting smaller signs. Sheriff Engeling stated he would provide the district with new signs.

Other Considerations

Shatter proof film was examined last year. Mrs. Ade requested quotes and found it would cost about 10-12 thousand dollars to cover all windows and doors with shatter proof film.

Chief Bland suggested school crossing guards be required to wear reflective vests. K9 checks should be expected in 2018 after training has been completed. Lori Ade discussed the possibility of the PD working with the bus driving staff to practice various security scenarios. Bonnie Sowarsh conducted a suicide awareness and prevention training with 7-12 grade students.
