Public inquired as to what the forum is for tonight's meeting. Chairman Mancini stated that the committee would listen to the various viewpoints tonight and put a committee together to review all the information and make recommendation back to the Policy Committee.

Parents and staff agree that the objective is the safety and well-being of our students and staff.

Past standing orders was a no Lice/nit policy. If a staff member suspected lice/nits they would send the student to the nurse to be checked, and if lice/nits were found, the nurse would contact the parent to take the child home for treatment. Classmates and family of the student would be sent to the nurse to be checked out for either return to class or to home.

The US Department of Education and the CDC worked together to provide guidelines to reduce the stigmatism of lice and procedures surrounding them. Dr. Conway stated that this is a very sensitive issue and we need more time to discuss all viewpoints, revisit the medical recommendation and to bring information forward to the Policy committee to make a recommendation to the Board of Education.

Policy revision takes months to go through because you have to draft a policy by the committee and then bring the policy to a regular Board meeting for a first and a second read before adoption. We will take our time to be thoughtful and deliberate and with a process of inclusiveness.

#### III. Review Policy on Lice

The policy is global as are most policies. We will continue with our current policy and nothing will be changed, if at all, until we go through the formal process.
