Support students to explore academic and non-academic interests

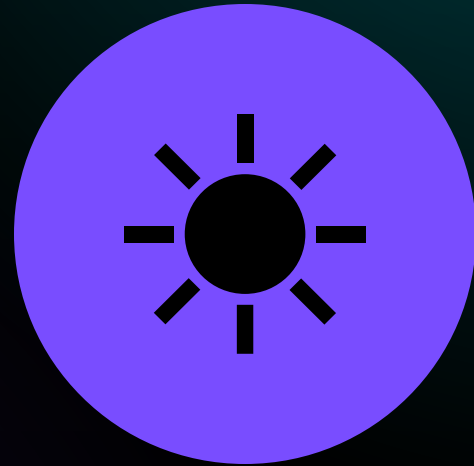


Support student intervention needs in math and reading

## **Willard Elementary Staffing**

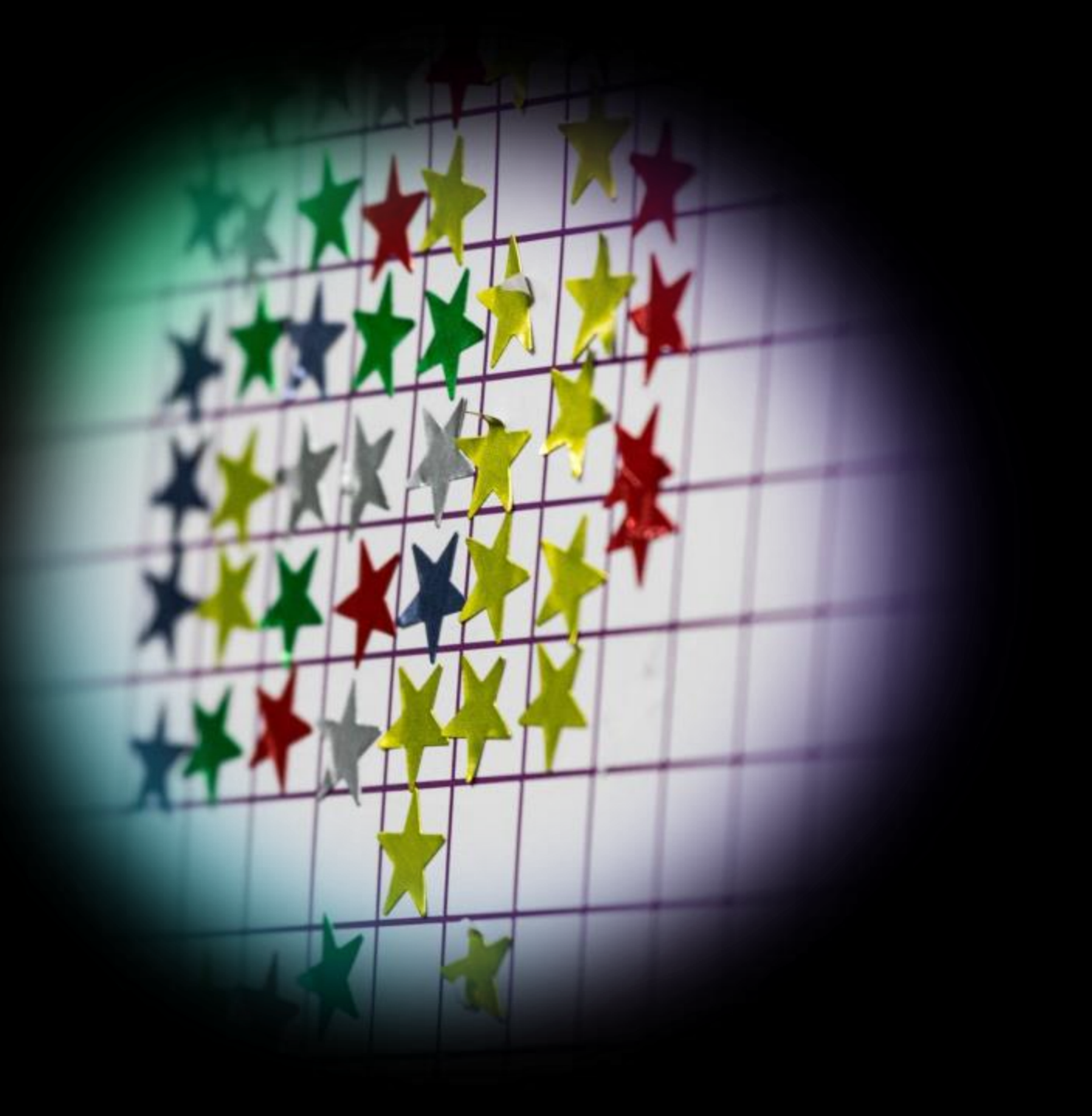

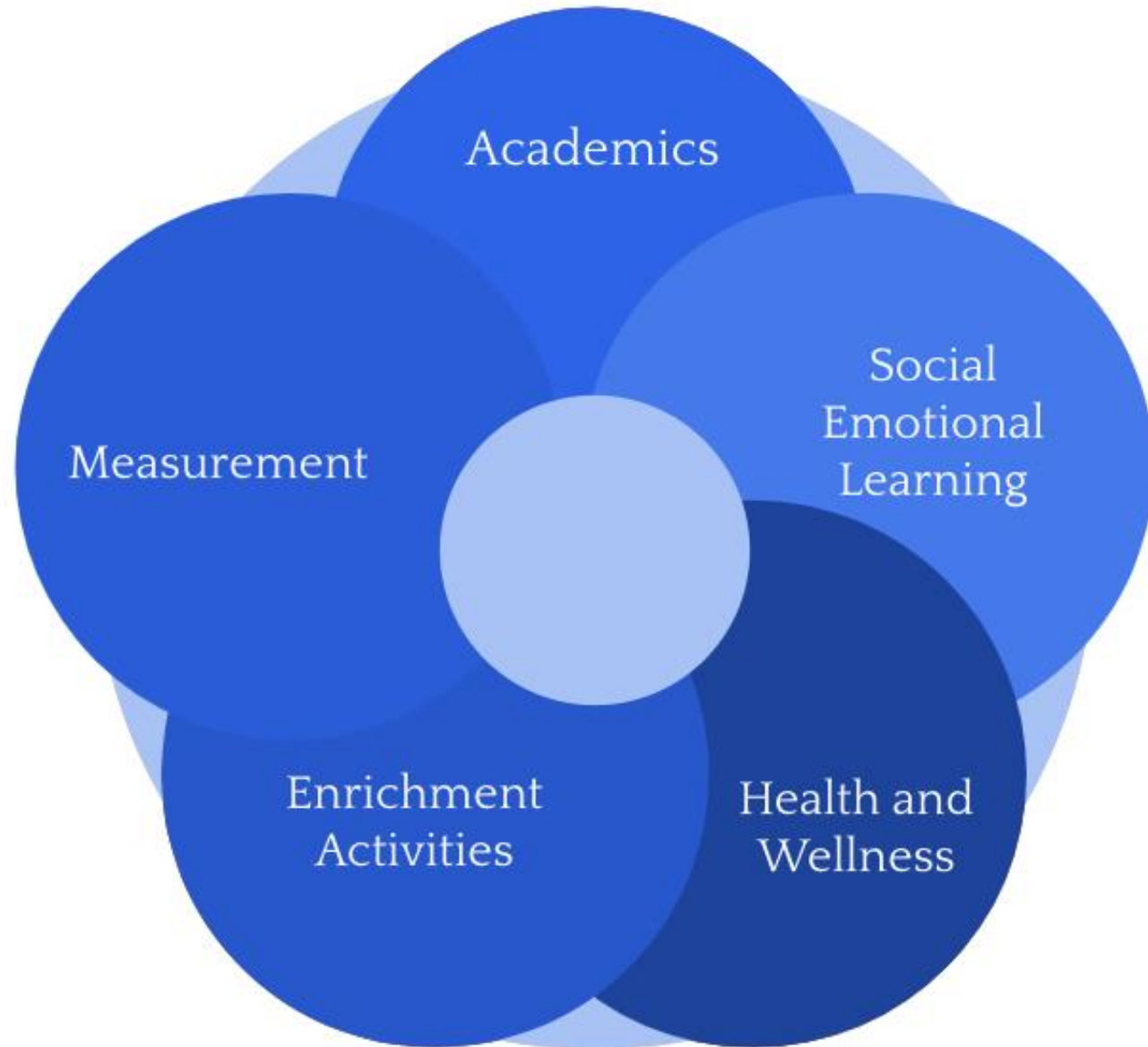
