Professional Development.

OPI was also here to support our district and each individual school with their instructional plans.

Instructional Coaches

September is a busy time for instructional coaches. Many mini-PD happen for new teachers as well as the veterans. These implementation plans were created during the August Principal/Coach planning time.

GRANTS

The Title I School Supports grants have been spent down. MCLP has carryover, but there will not be too much to carry over. The schools spent most of their allocation. I'm assured the new MCLP funding will be ready in egrants on the first

of October so I will meet with the principals next week to get their budget proposals ready so once the grant is available in egrants we are set to go.

Apparently, there was a discrepancy with the number of FIT students in our new ESSA grant so I have a conference call set up with OPI to figure out why the numbers are off. Once completed the ESSA will be completed. We need to make sure the FIT students are accounted for and receive their set-aside.

I will have the Fall baseline assessments in October, once we complete assessing in September.
