The approval of Frank Lloyd Wright's 8th Grade school field trip request to Boston, MA

## Background:

traveling from October 6 to October 9, 2027.

A learning opportunity is being offered to Frank Lloyd Wright 8th-grade students to visit historical sites in Boston, MA, to gain a deeper understanding of significant events in American history related to the American Revolution that will inspire cultural awareness and civic engagement with our nation's past. Students will walk the Freedom Trails, visit the historic sites of the 1620 Mayflower landing, Plimoth Pawtuxet and Lexington Green in the Concord/Lexington area among other sites such as the Boston Tea Party Ship & Museum and the Salem Witch Museum in Salem. Other notable stops include The Old North Bridge, Fenway Park and Harvard Square in Cambridge. Students will also take the Salem Ghost Tour to hear the tales made famous by the 1692 Salem Witch Trials.

The student expense will be \$2,434.00, which includes tours, transportation, tour guide, lodging, and meals.

The trip requires board approval per <u>Board Policy 2340</u> and <u>352-Rule</u> as is considered an extended USA (non-contiguous states) and International travel experience.
