Use of Cellular telephones (back to top)

Students shall not use or display electronic devices including cell phones during school hours.

A person who discovers a student using or displaying a cell phone without the written permission of the principal shall report the violation to a school administrator who shall confiscate the device and implement the appropriate consequences. Each school shall establish consequences, which may include fines, for the violation of the cell phone use policy and upon approval of the Board of Education shall publish those consequences in the school handbook.

A person who discovers a student using or displaying a cell phone *in a disruptive manner, shall* implement the appropriate consequences. Each school shall establish consequences, for the violation of the cell phone use policy and upon approval of the Board of Education shall publish those consequences in the school handbook.
