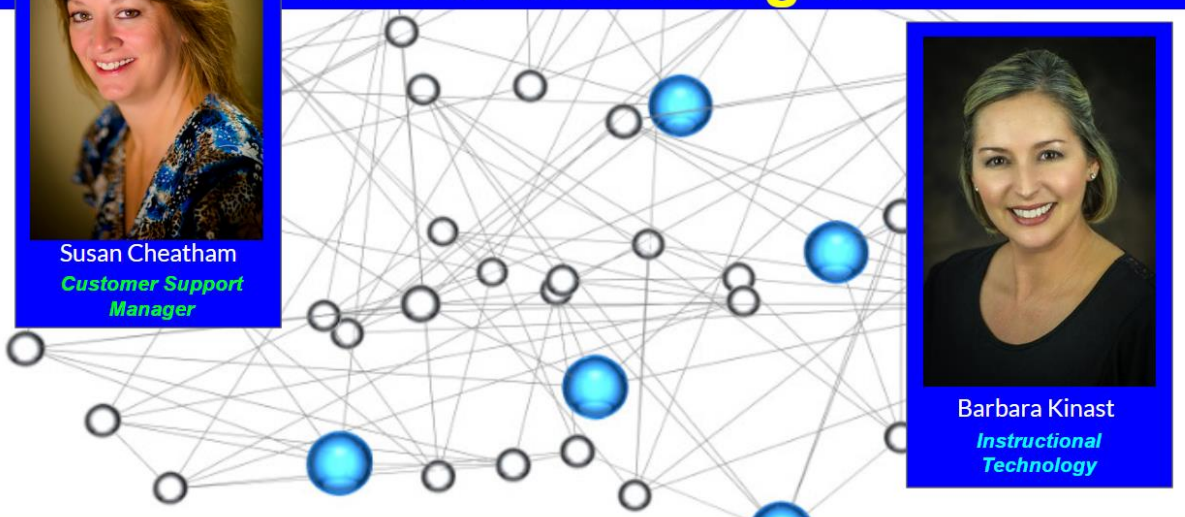
A situation at work that boosts up your energy or makes you feel productive.

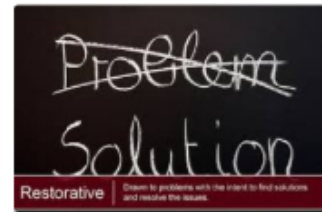


Featured Strength: Restorative
