Attendance:

- 286 students
- 63 students went to 5th Grade. 56 incoming Kindergarten students.
- 21 students moved
- 1 44 (49) 2 64 (68) 3 58 (57) 4 64 (66)
- New faces: 17 new students and 2 returning students (not counting our 56 new Kindergarten friends).

Contribution Focus – Family Connection Data Focus

- 95.2% attended Family Connection Meetings
- 14 Students/12 Families still working to personally connect with face to face
- 9/12 we have received paperwork
- Trends: Student interests more hands on in younger grades, more gaming, sports, animals, extracurricular in grades 2-4
- Trends: Parent goals for children making friends, becoming more independent, SEL and academic achievement
- Trends: Parent worries/concerns early communication
- Schoolwide Actions:

Things I learned from my Students Last Week:

- Think Win-Win isn't about winning a game. It is about how everyone feels. Both people feel happy about the solution!
- Short a makes an /ahh/ sound like in the words say, has, and even my name, Kash!
- 15 is greater than 10, but less than 20.
- Hot air balloons rise because the flames heat up the molecules in the air and make them bounce all over making the air less dense (crowded).
- The flap at the top of hot air balloons can be opened to let the hot air out, and the balloon floats down.
