BOARD GOAL:

Achieve TEA Recognized rating on our journey to becoming world-class by 2012

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Each year, the Texas Education Agency publishes a summary of campus, district, regional, and state data in a report called the Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS). The report reflects information from the previous school year, although some data is from two-year old PEIMS sources. Included in this report is a glossary of terms; state, regional, campus and campus comparison group performance data; and district/campus performance and profile information. The performance section details the results of the state testing program. The profile section gives an overall look at the district/campuses and compares it to a Campus Group, public schools that are demographically most similar to each campus, the district and state.

The AEIS report will be presented in a public forum on Monday, January 10, from 6:00 to 6:30 in the CHISD board room. Copies will be made available for additional review at each campus office and library as well as in the district administration reception area, City Hall, Chamber of Commerce, and the public library.
