RE: Specialized Transportation Bid

Recommendation

Administration recommends awarding Transportation Services for Special Education & Other Special Routes and Management to the following companies: **Safeway Transportation Services Corp, Septran, First Alt, and Britelift, Inc.** We are unable to calculate the total value of the contract, due to the highly variable transportation needs and the use of multiple vendors.

Background

Special Education transportation is a complex service that school districts are required to provide. The service is individualized, often transporting only one student at a time, with specialized needs (wheelchairs, booster seats, harnesses, etc.) and is characterized by frequent changes in schedules and physical needs. As such, multiple vendors, and first division vehicles (those motor vehicles designed for carrying less than 10 persons) are often used.

State law does not require that contracts for transportation be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. Instead, contracts providing for the transportation of pupils, must be advertised in the same manner as competitive bids, but may be awarded by first considering the bidder or bidders most able to provide safety and comfort for the pupils, stability of service, and any other factors set forth in the request for proposal regarding quality of service, and then price.

State law allows us to retain vendors that provide limited specialized transportation services on a year to year contract. Per the bid specifications for efficiency and cost-effectiveness, vendors can be awarded a 3.5-year contract (2025-2028) followed by a 2-year (2028-2030) renewed contract.

These transportation services were jointly bid with Lake Forest Districts 67 & 115. However, the business was rebid with lower insurance requirements, as the limits in the initial bid prevented some of the smaller companies from participating.

Current Situation

Nine companies submitted a bid response. The tabulation sheet is attached.

A thorough vetting process a part of the evaluation process. Reference checks were conducted to ensure the vendors' qualifications, reliability, and ability to meet the district's needs.

Safeway Transportation Services Corp. – Currently used in Districts 115 and 67 and we may be able to share routes. They have been reliable and specialize in wheelchair serviced vehicles, and have a competitive route cost for Division 1 vehicles.

Septran – Currently used in Districts 67 and 115 and we may be able to share routes. They have strong procedures, are able to meet the individualized needs of our learners and are experienced in special education transportation. They are the current contracted provider for True North 804.

First Alt – Part of First Student, a large and respected transportation company. They use exclusively first division vehicles and contracted employees.

BriteLift, Inc. – A smaller company that uses exclusively first division vehicles and contracted employees. We have had a very good experience with BriteLift from a safety and reliability standpoint with our students, even those who have extreme needs.

Olson Transportation, Inc. – Though we are not awarding the contract to Olson Transportation, as our contracted transportation provider for the District, we will continue using this company for special education students on regular bus routes under the existing contract. We also have the option of using them for specialized services under the terms of the current contract.

SECTION VII

Transportation Services Contract

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this 25th day of February, 2025, by and between the Board of Education of DISTRICT #65, Lake County, Illinois (“District”), and First Student, Inc. (“Contractor”) (collectively referred hereto as “Parties”).

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, District has requested public bids for the provision of special education transportation services & other special routes and management (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, Contractor has submitted a bid for provision of Services; and

WHEREAS, District has awarded the bid to Contractor to provide student transportation services in accordance with the bid specifications package.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. **Duration of Contract.** This Agreement shall be effective from January 1, 2025 through June 30, 2028. The Parties may mutually agree to extend the Agreement as allowed by law.

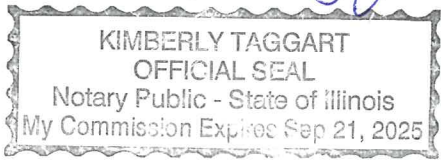



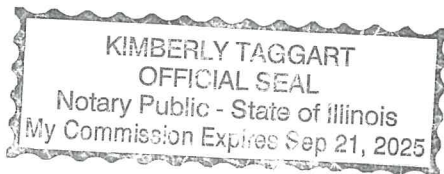

6. **Amendments.** No subsequent alteration, amendment, change, addition, deletion, or modification to this Agreement shall be binding upon the Parties unless reduced to writing and duly authorized and signed by each of them.
