


Fall to Spring Benchmarking Data & EOY Principal's Goals Update



In ELA, from Fall to Spring Benchmarking the colony schools remained the same in Tier 1 with 23 students and decreased Tier 3 by 2 students.



In Math, the colony schools had an increase in Tier 1 by 6 students from Fall to Spring Benchmarking and remained the same in Tier 3.


Principal's Instructional Goals & Action Steps

Academic Goal for the 21-22 School Year:

By June 2, 2022, Big Sky and Glendale Schools will decrease students in Tier III of the ELA and mathematics benchmark assessments by 50% as measured by the Aimsweb screening.

Interpretation- We will move 8 students from Tier 3 to Tier 2 in ELA and 12 students from Tier 3 to Tier 2 in mathematics.

EOY Results: In ELA the colony schools decreased Tier 3 by 2 students, as a result the principal's goal was unmet. In mathematics, we decreased Tier 3 by 6 students, although this goal was also not met we are proud of the work accomplished at both Big Sky and Glendale Schools. A challenge the colony schools faced from December-May was a shortage of staff to support the needs of students at both schools. The staff pulled together and visible gains were made even though our goals were not achieved.
