Special Ed – The Unit 40 Cross Categorical/LD ED and Out-of-District Cross Categorical/LD ED numbers are now reported separately for the total Enrollment Report.

Regular Ed Dually Enrolled – These numbers are still reported in the total Enrollment Report, but are not placed in the building's total. Rather, this number has its own category under the other buildings.

- o St. Anthony or Teutopolis student taking a miscellaneous course.
- o Any student, other than a Unit 40 student, taking a course for Dual Credit. Ex: Multimedia or C.A.D.

Regular Ed Tuition – Regular Education student who lives in another district who attends full time and pays full tuition to attend Unit 40.

Special Ed Dually Enrolled – Any special education student, other than a Unit 40 student, who enrolls to access special education services. *This student must take a class/course for a grade or credit in order to be considered dually enrolled.* A student who receives speech only or resource only is not considered dually enrolled.

Homebound/Hospital

- o Homebound – This student will have a doctor's prescription for homebound services.
- o Hospital – This student is temporarily placed for services. Examples: Pavilion, Meadows, etc.

Residential – Any student whose living arrangements become more permanent in order to receive services other than in Unit 40.

Residential = Swan, Gateway, Hope, The Pavilion, Echo Juv Det
