AGENDA ITEM: Report Out of the Finance and Audit Committee and Consideration of Approval of a Resolution Authorizing a Letter of No Opposition for Qorvo U.S., Inc. to File Foreign-Trade Zone Subzone Application

DISCUSSION: Approval of this resolution authorizes the District President to sign an agreement and issue a letter of no opposition to the Foreign-Trade Zones Board in support of Qorvo's subzone application. The request aligns with the Payment in Lieu of Taxes (Pilot) agreement between Collin College and Qorvo U.S., Inc., under which Qorvo will fully reimburse the District for any ad valorem tax exemption resulting from the Foreign-Trade Zone designation. As such, there will be no net financial loss to the District.

The proposed Foreign-Trade Zone designation is expected to encourage additional investment, enhance manufacturing and technology production capacity, support job creation, and promote economic growth within Collin County.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION: The District President recommends approval of a resolution authorizing a letter of no opposition for Qorvo US., Inc. to file a Foreign-Trade Zone Subzone application.
