Course Description: This course will focus on sharing information disseminated in a two year (6 course) training sequence that support staff participated in through Mid-Valley Special Education Cooperative. Strategies, observational tools, and frameworks will be provided. We will look at a multi-tiered systematic approach to understanding and programming for students with behavioral and social/emotional needs. Core beliefs surrounding behavior change and best practices in comprehensive program planning and implementation will be shared. This course stresses the preventative aspects of program planning for students who demonstrate behavioral difficulties within the school setting. Forms, procedures and resources for conducting Functional Behavioral Assessment, developing individual Behavior Intervention Plans (BIP), and observational tools to evaluate fidelity will be shared.
