Board Action Required

The number of open seats available are based on the caseload enrollment projections, class size limits, and student-teacher ratios. Caseloads are determined by School Board Policy 5113, 118.51, Wis. Stats., and Wis. Adm. Code Ch. P.I. 36. They are also determined by the intensity of the services required. Class sizes and caseloads vary, depending on the severity of need and the resources required to meet those needs. Students will not be denied open enrollment based on their disability.

The number of seats below does not represent student availability. The number of openings is in addition to students currently open enrolled in the district.
