We are basing our School Choice denial for Lee Jones Jr. based on the following rule regarding school choice:

2-1.03 These rules do not require a school district to add teachers, staff, or classrooms, or in any way to exceed the requirements and standards established by existing law.

If we accepted this student, as stated in their appeal, they want us to send them to the Sunshine school in Searcy. This is an expense to our school of \$24,000 a year per student. The Sunshine school is not even part of our district. The family is basically asking us to accept the student because their home school does not send students to the Sunshine school. If the student did not go to Sunshine, we would still have the expense of hiring a personal aid for the student. This has all originated from the fact that Hazen will not send students to the Sunshine school because of the expense. At Des Arc, we will send up to four or five but we have already reached that number. At this point, we do not feel that we can afford the cost associated with accepting this student.

Please find attached a school choice appeal filed with the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education by the Jones family. The family appeals the decision of the Des Arc School District. The DESE Rules Governing Public School Choice state that the nonresident and resident districts may file any response to an appeal within ten (10) days, not including weekends or legal holidays, of receipt of the appeal. I have attached a copy of the rules for your review. You may send responses directly to me. I am unable to contact the parent and cannot determine from the appeal packet who the resident district is. I wanted to ensure you were made aware of this appeal in plenty of time, but if you could tell me who the resident district is I would appreciate it.

All parties will receive a formal hearing notice detailing the date, time, and location of the hearing before the State Board of Education, but this appeal will be heard at the July State Board meeting. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
