





VI.	<p><u>AWARDING OF DIPLOMA</u></p> <p>State law allows local or regional school boards to award high school diplomas to honorably discharged World War II veterans who did not receive them because they left high school to serve in the armed forces (CGS § 10-221a (g)). The law does not define armed forces for the purpose of the awards. But CGS § 27-103 provides a definition that applies in cases where there is no definition. It defines “armed forces” as the U. S.
