(Draft)Instruction Class Size

The District will—strives to achieve ratios consistent with the State class-size recommendations pursuant to the following: When a class size exceeds the following number of students, then the class shall constitute a hardship to the District in accepting out of district students.

The enrollment of a student from another District or attendance zone shall also be deemed to constitute a hardship if the enrollment:

- A. Requires the hiring of additional staff;
- B. Requires provisions of educational services not currently being provided in the school:
- C. Causes overcrowding of existing classes; or
- D. Causes an excessive number of students in a particular building.


