### **Class Size**

The District ~~will~~ **strives** to achieve ratios consistent with the State class-size recommendations pursuant to the following: ~~When a class size exceeds the following number of students, then the class shall constitute a hardship to the District in accepting out of district students.~~

~~The enrollment of a student from another District or attendance zone shall also be deemed to constitute a hardship if~~ **the enrollment:**

- A. ~~Requires the hiring of additional staff;~~
- B. ~~Requires~~ provisions of educational services not currently ~~being~~ provided in the school;
- C. ~~Causes~~ overcrowding of existing classes; or
- D. ~~Causes~~ an excessive number of students in a particular building.
