Supporting Data (evidence of need): We are currently serving 202 Early Childhood Special Education students (0-6yrs) and 717 in our Early Childhood Family Education and School Readiness settings. Current model has been in place since the 80's. Two years ago, departments began to collaborate through a training and curriculum initiative. Current spaces are beginning to limit the ability to serve families and students. Current space limits the ability to expand services and options.
