Increasing CTE and College opportunities for elementary, middle and high school students and families

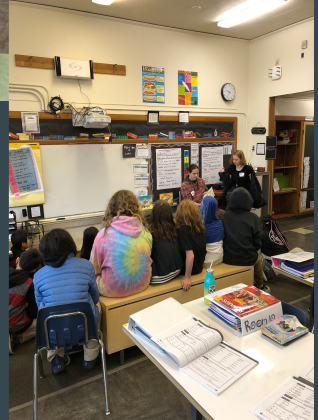
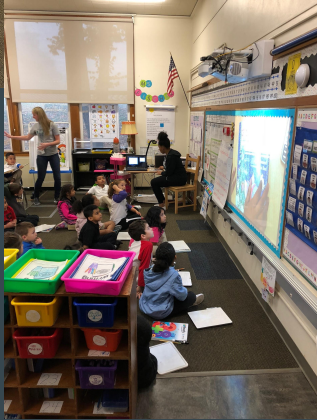
- Partnerships at all levels
