Due to a lack of funding from the State Legislature, the River Road ISD is currently considering making changes to the bus routing system next school year in an effort to save money. One of the changes being discussed would be to run two sets of duplicate bus routes, one being strictly for the elementary students, and the other being for intermediate/middle/and high school students. This might mean that the starting and ending times for school at various buildings might be changed because there would be approximately 45 minutes to an hour between the two routes. The primary benefits for this type of routing system would be:

- 1. To separate elementary students from older students.
- 2. Such a system would require fewer busses.
