Facility Condition Assessment Report

Background Information

WISD commissioned an existing facility needs assessment to better understand the condition of our existing facilities, to help the Board prepare a long-range facility master plan, and to provide information to the Board of Trustee's Facility Advisory of Citizens, Teachers, and Students (F.A.C.T.S.) Committee. The existing facility assessment was conducted under the supervision of PBK Architects and includes engineering, mechanical, structural, and material assessments. In addition to an assessment of existing facilities, an estimate of probable costs in today's dollars is included. Further, existing needs for each campus and district facility are categorized into priority needs vs. long term needs. The purpose of the existing facility needs assessment is to provide all stakeholders with a current assessment of facility conditions and help facilitate resource allocation to ensure we are able to fulfill the Weatherford ISD Mission, which is to educate, engage and empower each student in a safe and positive learning environment to discover and reach their greatest potential
