Rationale for Waiver

Heber Springs High School needs to be able to provide its students with more flexible scheduling options. We have several different areas which need improvement.

First and foremost, we need to expand course offerings and make them available to all students, without having to hire additional certified staff to teach those courses. We would like to utilize a digital learning classroom, as well as allow students to engage in content outside of the academic day (nights, weekends, vacations, etc.). We are a very rural, isolated high school, with great travel distances to larger towns. In spite of this hurdle, we would like our students to have many of the same opportunities for courses that students in more populated districts have. In order to achieve this, we need not only expanded digital course offerings, but also the flexibility for students who do have travel time during their academic day to be able to take classes outside of normal school hours. We believe this will provide further opportunities for career track students and encourage them to remain in school, thereby increasing our graduation rate. We would provide transportation for those students who participate in the Buildings & Trades and Medical Professionals programs offered by Conway Career Center. In addition, we would be able to provide more and varied courses for college-bound students and allow them to accumulate more hours of college credit prior to their Freshmen year at a university. They would do this at the Arkansas State University - Beebe systems Heber Springs Campus.

In addition, we would like to better serve our medically fragile students. We have a substantial student population who have medical needs that significantly affect their ability to attend school regularly. We try to accommodate them through Section 504 and Homebound Services. Often, however, even these measures are not enough to keep them enrolled. Subsequently, they join homeschool programs. The ability to keep them connected with their hometown school and peers is paramount. A more flexible

scheduling option would allow us to offer them public school at home or in a medical setting through digital delivery systems. We sincerely believe that if we can see them through their times of highest need, they will be better prepared to transition back into regular coursework when they become healthy enough. This will also increase their chances of graduation and pursuing their chosen path of post-secondary education.

Overall, we believe more flexible scheduling options will be beneficial to all parties. It will result in Heber Springs High School students having many opportunities which cannot be had under the status quo. It will give us the potential to draw back in some home-schooled students who have withdrawn in the past, as well as help us to retain those who would leave in the future. It will expand course opportunities for our career track and college bound students alike. We hope to better meet the educational needs of all our students and give them a greater pool of course offerings to choose from, and lead them to greater success after they graduate from Heber Springs High School.
