It is the intent of the Coppel Independent School District, a Chapter 41 district, to exercise Option 3 to achieve the required equalized wealth level for 2007-2008. An option 3 contract accompanies this letter. However, the district is currently coordinating with Regional Service Centers to potentially exercise Option 4 to benefit the Regional Consortium for Innovation. Any remaining WADA needed to achieve the required equalization wealth level when exercising Option 4, will be purchased through Option 3.

Coppel ISD expects to receive full benefit of the “efficiency credit” and/or “early payment credit” available to Chapter 41 school districts choosing Option 3 and/or Option 4, and will proceed with setting a tax rate for 2007-08. Contracts and other required remittances will follow in a timely manner.
