TITLE: A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A LETTER TO GOVERNOR DUNLEAVY WITH RESPECT TO RESCINDING A RECENT APPOINTMENT TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE  $2^{\rm ND}$  JUDICIAL DISTRICT SEAT

WHEREAS: Nome Public Schools exists to provide culturally responsive and high-quality educational opportunities for the children of Nome; and

WHEREAS: The mission of Nome Public Schools is to inspire and empower students to be culturally grounded responsible citizens who are deeply connected to our community and world; and

WHEREAS: The State Board of Education is statutorily responsible for leading the State Department of Education and carrying out its mission; and

WHEREAS: The bylaws of the State Board of Education direct that the Governor appoint a member from each of the four judicial districts and three members at large; and

WHEREAS: Governor William Dunleavy recently appointed Kimberly Bergey, a resident of Palmer Alaska to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District seat, which covers the northwest Alaska region covering the Bering Strait School District, Nome Public Schools, Northwest Arctic Borough School District and North Slope Borough School District; and

WHEREAS: The member of the State Board of Education appointed to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District is expected to represent the residents of the same; and

WHEREAS: A non-resident appointed to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District seat cannot represent the residents of the same and is in clear violation of the State Board of Education's own Bylaws.
