The meeting was called to order at 3:30 pm at HVHS with the pledge of allegiance.

We have a blocked out time at the end of next week to pull files and get organized by standard for our Accreditation Visitation. We will evaluate files with documentation, testing schedules, curriculum, and management. We will be set to continue compiling the data we need after the break.

We are working on a vision, mission mantra posters to hang in the hallways and classrooms. We want our vision, mission and school moto visible for kids and staff to see.

We are exploring options for changing our bells; we are going to a different ring tone. We are going to have our student aides play music the last minute of the passing period. We have student government kids making 60 second clips now and will play them. We are hoping to get kids to class on time and have less tardies.

Our Veterans Day Celebration went well. We will not want to have the Steak Feed and Auction the same week again. It was hard having two major events within days of each other. Our students were exceptional support and helped a lot with checking the Veterans in and serving the meal. The band and choir was excellent. We had 75 Veterans attend. We feed them a meal and they visited after the meal. We had more veterans show up to speak in classrooms with a variety of different testimonies. A parent donated the sound for the event and is planning to donate a presentation projector that will fill a 12' plus screen. We are looking at a screen to mount up on the wall in the gym for better visibility. We had a large number of parents, relatives attend the

Daye is going to go through Indistar and copy put the information into Advance Ed. The SIP is currently updated but the SIP goals will be aligned to the board goals.

We are focusing on Creativity & Rigor in our curriculum. This can be accomplished with project based assessment, open ended projects allow for rigor. Our PD session next week will be focused on creativity and rigor. Daye will be working with our teachers and teachers will be teaching each other to create meaningful lessons for assessment.

Essential Skills- we are making a master sheet for every senior with the dates they completed. The data will be a tracking mechanism so we can get all kids through.

December 14th Jen Perry will test a handful of kids with the work keys test. All sections, reading, oral expression and math all have to completed at one time. We are focusing on the kids essential skills in math and the students that have not passed.

Our College and Career Advocate is working on creating a pathway process. We are starting to organize classes in clusters. Kids will chose a pathway and then take classes that go with that pathway.

Cabaret is December 10th and will include a dinner and dessert auction.

The Hall of Fame will be scheduled in March this year at Hidden Valley. It will be a dessert social to honor our Hall of Fame Inductees.

We are planning to have the Booster Club Crab Feed at Hidden Valley on January 23rd to support our Facilities Project.
