#### **Curriculum/Instruction**:

<u>Daily Academic Intervention</u> - RTI Groups are up and running. Grade level PLC's created Intervention Groups based on our Fall Benchmark scores. Kindergarten - 3rd Grade students are in the process of completing the beginning of the year AMIRA IRI (Idaho Reading Indicator Assessment). The IRI is a month later than usual due to the state using the new assessment tool Amira. Our teachers gave the assessment in September to give our students the chance to use the new testing format. Letters will go home to parents to let them know about how their students scored. If students are Level 2 or 3 parents will receive a letter letting them know their child qualifies for some extra support in reading, and will receive intervention. The amount of intervention a student receives depends on their academic needs.

<u>VIP (Volunteer In-Service Program)</u>: The First VIP Trainings for the year were held on Tuesday, Sept. 16th 9:00 a.m. and at 4:30 p.m. There were around 12 total participants in the volunteer training.
