4 **Policy Name:** Student Conduct and Discipline

5 **Regulation:** 3200R

6  
7 **Applications of Sanctions**

8  
9 Discipline set forth by this policy will be inclusive for grades 4 through 12. Tobacco violation will be considered  
10 separately from drug and alcohol (see below).

11  
12 Use or possession of alcohol or drugs of any kind is a violation of Montana State Law. For on or off campus  
13 violations in regard to use of alcohol and drugs 1) including all illegal drugs as well as prescription drugs that  
14 have not been prescribed by a physician for that student and 2) tobacco products, including smokeless tobacco  
15 and nicotine devices such as electronic cigarettes or a positive drug test would be treated separately for in-season  
16 athletes/~~performers/club members~~ **BHS Activities that have the ability to earn a letter** and other school  
17 sponsored activities as listed in the BHS Activities Handbook; Browning School District #9 will apply the  
18 following sanctions:

20 **First Offense:** (we will use the one adopted in 3525) ~~Student is suspended for the season for that sport~~

21  
22 **Second Offense:** (we will use the one adopted in 3525)  
23 ~~Immediate removal from all activities for the remainder of the school year.~~

24  
25 **Third Offense:** (we will use the one adopted in 3525  
26 ~~Student is suspended for the remainder of the season.~~

27  
28 **Fourth Offense:** Immediate removal from all activities for the remainder of the school year.

29  
30 For both, first and second offence, these are dealt with administratively pending a review by the Board of Trustees  
31 to determine that the pupil was involved in the incident or infraction as per MCA 20-5-201.

32  
33 During periods of suspension, a student will be allowed to attend and participate in practice sessions. During the  
34 suspension period the student will not be allowed to wear his/her school uniform, be present in the locker rooms,  
35 or travel with the team for home or away competitions. The student remains ineligible until ~~Insight or other~~  
36 ~~district approved intervention program training is completed.~~ They are participating in Healing to Wellness  
37 Program for prevention and intervention.

38  
39 If a student activity participant is the subject of ~~two~~ (dependant upon policy 3525) violations of either policy 3200  
40 or 3525 during any given school year, he or she will be suspended from participation in extra/co-curricular  
41 activities for the remainder of that school year.

42  
43 **Tobacco**

44 **First Offense:** Seven (7) **calendar** day suspension to include at least one competition. If competitions have not  
45 begun by the end of the 7<sup>th</sup> day period, the athlete will be suspended from the first competition that takes place.

46  
47 **Second Offense:** **Fifteen (15) calendar days suspension.**

48  
49 **Third Offense:** **Thirty (30) calendar day suspension.**

50  
51 **Fourth Offense:** Suspended from team for the remainder of that season

52  
53 For each consecutive sport/activity season, athletes violating the tobacco policies will start over in terms of

1 offense and consequence.
