Trip Details

For every six students that go, they include one chaperone to go at no expense. We will be holding an informational meeting, Oct. 13 at 6:30pm in room 30 at the High School.

Itinerary

Day 1: Fly overnight to Italy

Day 2: Milan and Venice

Day 3: Venice

Day 4-5: Florence

Day 6: Assisi and Rome

Day 7: Rome

Day 8: Cinecitta film studios, Rome

Day 9: Depart for home

Rationale

Italy has a strong history in film. In addition to immersing in the Italian culture and gaining amazing life experiences, we will be observing Italian cinema sites. The main film experience we will have is spending a day at the world-famous Cinecitta (translated as "Film City") near Rome. Cinecitta is an enormous studio with large sets for Italian and International films. We will tour the studio and are also hoping to film there as special guests.

Cost and Payment

This trip normally would cost over \$8000, but the student cost is \$3350 excluding spending money, passport fees, etc. We will be doing fundraising opportunities, and students will be directed to apply for grants. Payment plans are available. Additional adults will cost \$3685.
