ITEM: VII.E.

TOPIC: Approval to Relocate Perrinville Programs

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District direct the District's administration to relocate current programs at the Perrinville Early Childhood Center to other facilities within the school district beginning with the 2015-2016 school year. Further, the Board of Education directs the administration to obtain designs and cost estimates for additional rooms to be erected at Jackson Early Childhood Center to house the preschool ASD program for the purpose of housing ASD and ECP programs in the same facility, and have the designs and cost estimates brought back to the Board for consideration.

RATIONALE:

Moving the Perrinville programs is a cost saving measure for the school district.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The relocation of Perrinville programs will save the district an estimated \$218,000 in the annual operating budget.
