Action Taken:

TL4.2 - Full Implementation - Journeys, Envisions, and Accelerated Math assessments are given regularly. STAR reading and math assessments are given at least 3x yearly and have accompanying reports tied to Common Core standards.

TL4.1 - Full Implementation- Journeys ELA Curriculum, Envisions, Accelerated Math, and Scholastic News are all aligned to Common Core. Teachers plan science and social studies aligned with state standards (evident in lesson plans)

TL4.3 - Partial Implementation -Teachers meet with Principal, Title 1, and ERC Teacher every 6 weeks to discuss assessment data at 20% meetings and 3 times a year for 100% meetings. Accelerated Math reports provide skills-based information. Next steps involve sharing data with EAs (teacher will share test scores and Principal will share OPM

TL4.4 - Partial Implementation -We have a strong Reading intervention program in place for intensive readers. Teachers use leveled and decodable reader and acclereated readers to provide students with reading practice on their level. Journeys curriculum provides challenge materials (ie - additional vocab, etc). Accelerated math and individualized fact drills are utilized to differentiate based on skills. The staff is continuously seeking ways to challenge the high achieving learners (ie., what to do with students who pass pre-tests).
