**Project Synopsis:**



Holaway Elementary has a 90% free and reduced lunch rate which correlates to the lack of technology our students have available for them at home. This project would promote STEM education at our school allowing teachers to have supplies readily available to be used in the classroom. The different items allow for differentiation among grade levels. It is also important as teachers to introduce students to different academic areas in order to promote different areas of focus when they enter high school and college. It also offers a glimpse of future careers in STEM areas for our students.
