General purpose of the project:

Provide an objective and the purpose of the project

To help promote STEM learning at Holaway Elementary, a STEM closet was created for teachers to have resources for multiple activities readily available to use in the classroom. Our closet currently does not have technology items that are used for coding. This project would create items to be readily available for teachers spanning the grade levels served at Holaway Elementary, PreK-5.

Project Synopsis:

STEM is growing in popularity as an important subject to be taught at all grade levels starting in preschool. Holaway Elementary has a 90% free and reduced lunch rate which correlates to the lack of technology our students have available for them at home. This project would promote STEM education at our school allowing teachers to have supplies readily available to be used in the classroom. The different items allow for differentiation among grade levels. It is also important as teachers to introduce students to different academic areas in order to promote different areas of focus when they enter high school and college. It also offers a glimpse of future careers in STEM areas for our students.

Evaluation and Sustainability plan:

This project is to introduce technology and coding to students. Just by exposing our students to the different concepts of STEM, we are providing ideas for their future.

All of the items listed are sustained on their own. They do not rely on outside technology in order to work. The only item that may be needed would be batteries which can be found in the STEM closet for teachers to
