At the time of these board meetings, counselors have input student schedules and have met with students. We have broken down our class requests and compared them to the number of teachers and sections that we have available. This tells us what teachers, etc we need for next year. This information has been turned over to Mrs. McMullen, Dr. Kauffman, and Mrs. Epley.

Interim assessments have begun for our EOCs. English took their interim assessments the last week of February. The week before Spring Break Algebra 1 and US History took their interim assessments. The week after Spring Break Biology will take their interim assessments. Interim Assessments are EOC aligned 'practice' tests written by TEA where we take the data from the assessments and analyze where our students have been successful and where we need more work before the actual EOC.

From the English EOC we identified four TEKS in English I and five TEKS in English 2 that provided us with some 'low hanging fruit'. How to reteach or how we will teach these TEKS will help our students be more successful on the EOC in April.

The Athletic Director, High School Principal, Chief Academic Officer, Fine Arts Director, and Junior High Principal, Academic Dean and counselors have all met to discuss the location of athletics and fine arts in the master schedule. We are considering varsity boys athletics first period, girls athletics fourth period, 9th grade boys athletics seventh period, junior varsity band first period, and varsity band second period.

At press time for this board report (see more update information in the Friday memo) we are sending four powerlifting girls to state and the boys regional was on March 6th.
