- The end of the school year and all the end of the year events (Senior Awards and Scholarship Ceremony and Graduation) all went well. Special thanks to Lori Fangmeier, Jodi Arndt, and Jennifer Rustad for all of their hard work organizing these events.
- Our summer credit recovery program is up and running. There are two sessions that are offered during the summer. The sessions are scheduled Monday through Thursday from 8am to noon on June 9th through July 3rd and July 7th through July 31st. There were 29 students (compared to 47 in 2021, 27 in 2022, 27 in 2023, 29 in 2024) invited to participate in the program. In the first session there are currently 17 students participating. We anticipate 5 more to start in July. Mr. Torgerson, Ms. Liljenquist, Ms. Holland, and Mr. Cannon are all helping with our credit recovery program this summer.
- Handbooks submitted are updated with current dates, names, and policies.
- Summer activities include working on schedules, reviewing student data, completing reports for MDE, and planning for back to school workshops for the 2025-2026 school year. We are also working on finding a special education teacher and paraprofessionals.
