# **Components of Safe Schools**



- Active Shooter Training, CPR, and Mental Health (CIT)
- Automated Records Management Systems (ARMS) Mobile
- Dog Searches
- Police One Academy
- Monitoring cameras throughout district campuses
- Officers assist with drills at campuses
- Radio communications with SAPD/SAFD
- Raptor System
- Installed Interior and exterior cameras at all campuses.
- Electric locks throughout the district
- Buzzer door with camera system at campuses
- District wide radio system to include communication with transportation, police and administration
- Alarm Monitoring Services District facilities and campuses
- Metal detectors
- Facilities Lighting and Fencing
- Cameras inside district buses
- Internet filters monitors suspicious activity





#### Navigate Prepared System - Internal Communication

- Will create the District and Campus EOP(s) (Safety Wizard)
- Will have Flip Charts of all our codes and procedures
- Will have an accountability system that all the teachers' rosters are uploaded into the system and it
  updates itself every 24 hours. This will allow us to account for all students and staff in any emergency
  situation.
- Will allow any staff member to call a code. This will alert every person on the campus thread of the code even if their phone is turned off it will come over like an Amber Alert. This will also contact 911 immediately.
- Will log in and store all drilling information for the campus.
- Will assist with the Audit Process
- Use exiting campus maps to identify locations of emergency equipment, exits, and 360 degree virtual view of the classrooms.
