NSBSD Policy Manual:

Board Bylaw 9311, Board Policies:...Prior to adoption, policies shall normally be given two readings by the Board. At its second reading, the policy may be adopted by a majority vote of all members of the Board.

NSBSD Strategic Plan Summary:

1.0 Prioritize and implement intentional and purposeful partnerships.

Issue Summary:

BP 3515.5, Restrictions on Sex Offenders on Campus (New) is a new policy recommended for adoption by the Association of Alaska School Boards that prohibits non-parent sex offenders from coming onto school grounds and that puts reasonable procedures in place for sex offenders that are parents of students enrolled in district schools.

Section 8000, Community School Advisory Council is a draft provided by the District's Attorney according to the direction of the Board at the Summer Retreat to clarify the SAC's role.
