<u>Opening Remarks by Superintendent</u>: Dr. Scott Muri congratulated Trustees Delma Abalos on winning the Odessa College OC Honors Outstanding Teacher Award and Dr. Steve Brown on his election to the Texas Association of School Boards Board of Directors. Dr. Muri also thanked ECISD police for taking initiative to recommend the purchase of a K-9 Unit. The officer and weapons dog should be hired, trained and ready to visit schools in the spring semester.

Report/Discussion Items

<u>Local Revenue Sources (First Reading)</u>: Deputy Superintendent Dr. Stephanie Howard presented this item for discussion. All revenues derived from the licensing of the Permian High School and Odessa High School trademarked logos shall be placed in a designated account for the purpose of awarding annual scholarships to Permian HS and Odessa HS current District graduates as outlined in Regulations.

<u>Other Revenues: Gifts and Solicitations (First Reading)</u>: Deputy Superintendent Dr. Stephanie Howard presented this item for discussion. The Board delegates to the Superintendent or designee the authority to accept unsolicited gifts on behalf of the District. However, any gift with a market value of \$10,000 or more, any gift that the potential donor has expressly made conditional upon the District's use for a specified purpose, or any gift of real property, shall require Board approval. Once accepted, a gift becomes the sole property of the District.

Presentation on HB3 Implementation of Full Day Pre-Kindergarten in 24890 ECISD: Associate Superintendent of Curriculum & Instruction Dr. Lilia Náñez presented this item for discussion. Research shows full-day pre-kindergarten benefits students by improving children's receptive and expressive vocabulary; improving literacy skills in reading and writing; improving emotional learning; and improving school readiness. Currently, most ECISD pre-k students attend for half of a day as compared to those in full-day pre-k at Schools of Choice. A high quality, full-day pre-kindergarten program is needed, and ECISD is committed to putting that in place next year for all eligible students. Eligibility qualifications are defined by the Texas Education Agency. Those requirements are English learners; participants in free or reduced lunch program; Homeless; a child of an active duty member of the armed forces; a child of a member of the armed forces who was injured or killed while serving on active duty; in foster care: a child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award. To make the move to full-day pre-kindergarten will require 23 additional teachers and/or partnerships with state-approved providers like Head Start (this will allow ECISD to accommodate eligible students as well as those who are tuitionbased). As these plans are developed District administrators will decide where additional pre-k classrooms will be located.
