■ In August, HSA discontinued its partnership with the SER Jobs organization and is now collaborating with the Workforce Center in Walker County. The goal of this collaboration is to provide HSA students with internships and post-secondary career/college opportunities.



- HSA has again collaborated with many of our community partners to receive generous donations in the form of snacks and gift cards for our HSA's incentive program.
- HSA has again partnered with the SHSU Sociology Department, Dr. Adana Alexander for the spring semester. Dr. Alexander's students will mentor HSA students on goal setting, alcohol/substance abuse awareness, mental health & other health-care related issues that prevent our students from thriving after graduating from high school.


His long-term goal is to complete his studies at Texas A&M University and launch his own electrical company.
