## **Background Information**

Duncanville High School Collegiate Academy provides 11th and 12th-grade students the opportunity to attend dual credit courses at Mountain View College as part of the district's commitment to college and career readiness. Mountain View College operates on a modified instructional calendar with fewer than the state-required 75,600 instructional minutes, including intermissions and recesses. To align with this schedule and ensure compliance with attendance accounting regulations under Education Code 48.005(g) and 48.007(a), Duncanville ISD seeks approval for a waiver.

This waiver allows instructional time spent in dual credit courses to count toward the minimum instructional hours required for students to be considered full-time for Average Daily Attendance (ADA) funding. Board Policy EHDD supports students earning high school and college credits simultaneously, enhancing opportunities for academic achievement and postsecondary success.

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board approve the submission of the waiver to the Texas Education Agency to ensure dual credit course time at Mountain View College counts toward state-required instructional minutes.
