New Denton High School Classroom Display & Audio-Visual Technology Purchase October 26, 2021

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from ProComputing Corporation in the amount of \$892,097.74 for the classroom display and audio-visual technology purchase for the new Denton High School.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This purchase will provide the classroom display and audio-visual technology for the newly constructed Denton High School campus that is scheduled to be turned over to the District April 2022.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The classroom display and audio-visual technology will be purchased from ProComputing Corporation through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (TIPS) contract award. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the 2018 Bond Authorization.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and have the classroom display and audiovisual technology installed once the District receives temporary certificate of occupancy of the building.
