The high schoolers are enjoying their photography class which includes general photography instruction, wildlife photography with telephoto lenses, how to use trail cameras, and more. The elementary students are also enjoying their art classes. All students of Hyder School are liking Mr. and Mrs. Haugen, our new teachers, they both have made the school very colorful and fun.
