

# Planning for First Football Game

# Tickets

Tickets will be sold at three gates

Multiple gates are needed to accommodate parking and the complexity of entry into the field

Locations:

- Bottom of upper stairway
- Main gate in parking loop
- Library parking lot

Gates cover open access points and give best access to elderly and disabled fans

Pricing: Adult \$5, Senior Citizen \$1, Students free for first game

# Traffic

The Derby PD will assist with traffic control

The Derby PD will coordinate with the Police Auxiliary to control traffic

The fire lane adjacent to the field house will be blocked to prohibit illegal parking

The police are contacted before each game to verify the amount of coverage needed

# Parking

Parking is available at:

- Derby HS lot
- Parking loop
- Library lot
- Street

Library lot is reserved for people with parking passes

Parking loop is reserved for officials, doctor, busses, 1 supply vehicle, 1 concession vehicle, secondary emergency vehicle if needed. Also has four handicap spaces. Two spaces reserved for special guests.

Both lots will have attendants to control/direct traffic

Library lot will open to general public 15 minutes after start of game

# Crowd Control

Police will be present to assist with crowd control

All gates onto field will be closed at all times

Access to baseball field will be blocked

Access to balcony will be allowed

Access onto field will be granted to coaching staff, chain crew, trainers, doctors, administrators, and individuals with sideline passes

SSO's can be a further asset for crowd control

Game workers and police will secure crowd to allow players on and off field

# Other Concerns

-Security will be needed at press box access road. This is an open entrance into the bleachers.

This is an unlighted and unimproved path.

-There is an open hill below the press box. There will be markings to stop access. This hill is not safe for spectators.

# Access to Field House

Visiting team will have access to locker room

Officials have a designated changing room

Only lower-level lavatories will be open

Balcony access is allowed. All upper-level rooms will not be accessible.

AD will control access to guest locker room and officials room

# Busses

Busses will park in bus lane located in parking loop

Busses will park by the main gate leading to locker room

AD/Police will maintain a path to allow players safe access to and from locker room



# Emergency Personnel

The athletic trainer will be stationed with the football team

EMT's will be present and stationed near the visitor bleachers

Four police officers will be assigned to the game

Police Auxiliary will be present for traffic control

SSO's are a further emergency asset

# Emergency Vehicles

Police will have the fire lane available for vehicles

Police will have access to parking loop if needed

Ambulance will be located inside gate by visitor bleacher

EMT's may also bring a smaller vehicle if they need to drive onto turf

The ambulance will not drive onto track or turf

In the case of a serious injury, the ambulance could go onto field

# Concessions

Concessions will be run by the Booster Club

The contact person is Tony Gonzalez

The club has already secured the funding, permits, and insurance to operate the concession stand

Concessions are located on the lower level of the field house

PTO will be selling DHS clothing at the game

PTO will be located in vicinity of the concessions area
