BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Due to the ongoing concerns of the H1N1 flu, the District closed two campuses from May 1-6, 2009 and closed all campuses from May 4-6, 2009. TEC Citation 21.401 © provides the District the avenue to petition the Commissioner of Education for a reduction in the number of days of service for educators, and this approval would not reduce the educator's salary. Educator is defined as a person who is required to hold a certificate issued by the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC). Other employees (non educators) are not covered under this particular citation.

-Continuation of employee salaries/employee pay by an official action of the Board of Trustees
