1. Recognition

- The speech team paced 4th in the section and 7 students advanced to the section finals, with Matt Swanson moving on to compete at State
- The student council was recognized as a National Gold Council of Excellence
- SADD students packed more than 25,000 meals at Feed My Starving Children
- NHS blood drive collected from more than 50 people
- The FFA served a teacher appreciation breakfast on National Ag Day

2. Teachers as Learners

- All High School Staff participated in a professional development day on 4/1

 - ii. A team of staff presented on best practice for addressing disruptive behaviors in class
 - iii. Staff members presented technology workshops for each other looking ahead to next year

- Upcoming Assessments: MCA Math for 7th, 8th, and 11th graders, MCA Science for 8th and 11th graders, and AP tests

- Adding an 8th grade reading class (semester) and ELA elective offering
- Adding "non-traditional" STEM and technology offering Patrick Shipway will be working directly with students regularly to deliver mini-units or work with teachers to implement STEM ideas into our courses
