This AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between Wharton County Junior College ("WCJC"), acting by and through its governing body, the Board of Trustees, and the Wharton Independent School District ("DISTRICT"), acting by and through its governing body, the Board of Trustees.

	WCJC shall donate the used manikins identified in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part of hereof for all purposes, in its "as is" condition, with all existing faults and with no implied warranty of merchantability and no implied warranty of simulation for a particular purpose.

- 1.03 The DISTRICT shall accept the manikins described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part of hereof for all purposes, as is, in the current condition.
- 1.04 To the extent permitted by law, the DISTRICT agrees to hold harmless and release WCJC, their agents, officers, directors, employees, assigns and successors, from any and all loss, damage, suits, judgements, attorney's fees, causes of action of any nature or kind, for loss or damage to property or for injury or death to persons, arising out of caused by, or occurring in any manner from the use of the donated manikins.

This interlocal agreement constitutes the entire agreement between WCJC and the DISTRICT. Any oral representations or modifications concerning this agreement shall be of no force or effect except a subsequent modification in writing signed by WCJC and the DISTRCIT.

III.

Nothing in this agreement may be construed as creating any personal liability on the part of any officer, director, employee, or agent of any public body that may be a party to the agreement and the parties expressly agree that the execution of the agreement does not create any personal liability on the part of any officer, director, employee, or agent of WCJC.

IV.

The validity, interpretation, and performance of this agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas. This agreement is fully performable and enforceable in Wharton County, Texas, wherein venue hereunder shall lie.
