 - 1 student will graduate from the LCSC welding program and return to the area




Current enrollment in MDCAP

Tiny Home Project










The Tiny Home Project: Hikari Box Model

- Compact, efficient 184 sq.
 ft. layout with large windows and natural light.
- Focused on sustainable design and craftsmanship.
- Combines solar-ready power systems and energy-efficient construction.





Learning from the Ground Up

- Students complete every stage of the build:
 - Wall framing and sheathing
 - Roofing, insulation, and siding
 - Finish carpentry and paint
- Develops problem-solving and project sequencing skills.

Construction Trades

- Enrolled in CWI Electrical
 Apprenticeship course through
 Workforce training
- Transition to any area of the construction trades
 - Students will not only work with the general, who is mentoring the project, but also subspecialty contractors.

 - Electrical






Animal Care

 - Guided by Pathways




Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA)

Emergency Medical Technician

- Students will prepare for the national EMT certification exam
